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## VET4NAI PROJECT

VET for NAI is an ambitious Erasmus+ project that aims at the rapid and effective integration of newly arrived immigrants (NAIs) into the labour market through training that integrates familiarisation with the language of the host country and offers skills.

The Guidance Toolkit will be based on empowering newly arrived immigrants, focusing on active choice on their entrance into the labour market.

**The VET4NAI project aims to investigate current national barriers to the effective integration of newcomers into the labor market and their needs, and to develop a career guidance toolkit on this basis.**

### VET4NAI project - Progress April-Nov 2023

The partners from Sweden, Italy, Greece and France, gathered together for a Transnational Partners Meeting in Larissa in July 2023. They were able to discuss the next steps to take for the development of the Guidance toolkit (PR2) and the training handbook.

As we advance the VETforNAI initiative, we're fine-tuning our Toolkit and training sessions based on partner feedback. Led by Dimitra, with Fispes spearheading, our efforts focus on immigrant labor market integration. Intensified dissemination and efficient project management ensure transparency. Preparation for upcoming meetings underscores our commitment to progress.

our Training Handbook summary, developed by TrimTab and FISPE with partners DIMITRA and EFFEBI. It's the result of our commitment to growth from September 2023 to April 2024. Central to our approach is Result 3 (R3), focusing on key milestones. Our modular distance course format spans six collaborative modules for flexible, immersive learning.



## Results Achieved So Far: Progress Highlights

### Comprehensive Stakeholder Needs Mapping (R1)

Partners completed Result 1 by mapping stakeholder needs for integrating new immigrants into the labor market. Insights gathered guide subsequent activities effectively.

### Development of Toolkit (R2)

A milestone was reached with the development of the Toolkit, providing tailored vocational guidance to new immigrants. Partners collaborated closely to design and refine it, ensuring relevance and effectiveness in supporting immigrants and counselors.

### Development of (R2) Training curriculum (handbook) for guidance staff

We've started developing a training curriculum for guidance staff, covering assessment, module creation, implementation, evaluation, and refinement. Aimed at supporting immigrant integration into the labor market.

### Dissemination Efforts and Project Visibility

The project's visibility expanded through active participation in conferences, seminars, and events. Dissemination activities, including articles and press releases, effectively communicated goals and outcomes. We remain committed to advancing objectives and impacting immigrant labor market integration.

## Next steps

### Toolkit Refinement and Finalization

After the Larissa meeting, we'll finalize the Toolkit, incorporating partner and stakeholder feedback. Dimitra will ensure its technical development for implementation.

### Training Needs Assessment, Module Development and Implementation of Training Sessions:

Partners are working on conducting the Training Needs Assessment (R3.1), through surveys and interviews to tailor training materials effectively. Module development for the Training Handbook will continue, with each partner refining content and aligning it with project goals.

### Dissemination

Efforts to disseminate project outcomes will intensify through conference participation, article publication, and newsletter distribution. Partners will use multiple channels to raise awareness and share project insights.

### Project Management and Evaluation

Project management tasks will continue with diligence, ensuring timelines, budget management, and communication. Evaluation will focus on progress, challenges, and performance optimization.

### Preparation for TPM4 and LTTA

Partners will start preparations for the upcoming TPM4 in Italy, scheduled for January 2024, as well as the subsequent LTTA in Greece in June 2024
