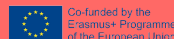

'VET for NAI' project aims to create tools for early and effective integration of newly arrived immigrants (NAIs) into the labour market through integrated training, which targets to enhance the host country language as well as technical skills in their job field.

The project addresses the need to promote integration of NAIs into the labour market through strengthened cooperation and mobilization of employers and social and economic partners in each country.
